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# Sponsored Research Support Background


- University of Illinois Sponsored Research Profile
  - ~\$1B / year in externally sponsored research support.
  - > 1000 different sponsors.
  - ~ 50% of institutional faculty, graduate students and staff involved in Research.
- Inefficient Research Administration Support Infrastructure
  - Campus by campus basis with different business processes.
  - Software applications (InfoEd, RISC, IBC Project Registration, IACUC Registration) work in silos.
  - Significant supplemental manual processing.

University of Illinois is one of top Research Universities in US.


However, current Research support is sub-optimal with manual intensive business processes using a myriad of software solutions with each working in silo.

# What is START myResearch?

- **START** = Systemwide Tools for Administration of Research and Training.
  - Use Quali Coeus (KC) Open Source Software for Research Administration.
  - Targeting the KC COI (Conflict of Interest), followed by Pre-Award, IRB (Institutional Review Board), and IACUC (Institutional Animal Care and Use Committees).
- **myResearch** = Principal Investigator Portal (PI Portal).
  - Web portal.
  - Central point for both faculty members and staff to access information on a grant, including financial data, from inception to closure.
  - Will display compliance and other information in future phases.



KC is used by 2 dozen higher education institutions and is proven to be effective in meeting sponsored research support needs.



myResearch is being built based on best practices seen in Penn St. and UCLA.



# START myResearch Goals

- Deliver efficient operational support of research to serve and maintain a large and complex sponsored research portfolio.
- Reduce faculty burden and effort.
  - Integrate grant preparation, approval, submission, routing, and compliance.
  - Single point of entry and user friendly PI interface.
- Permit the institution to maintain compliance and competitiveness.
- Drive consensus best practice business processes for University-wide IT support.



# Oversight & Governance

- **START myResearch**

- Funded by the Vice Chancellors of Research in Chicago and in Urbana.
- In collaboration with the Office of the Administrative Information Technology Services (AITS).



- **Executive Oversight Committee**

- Provide executive oversight and decision-making through **bi-weekly meetings** and supported and administered by staff from the Project Leadership Committee.

- **Project Leadership Committee**

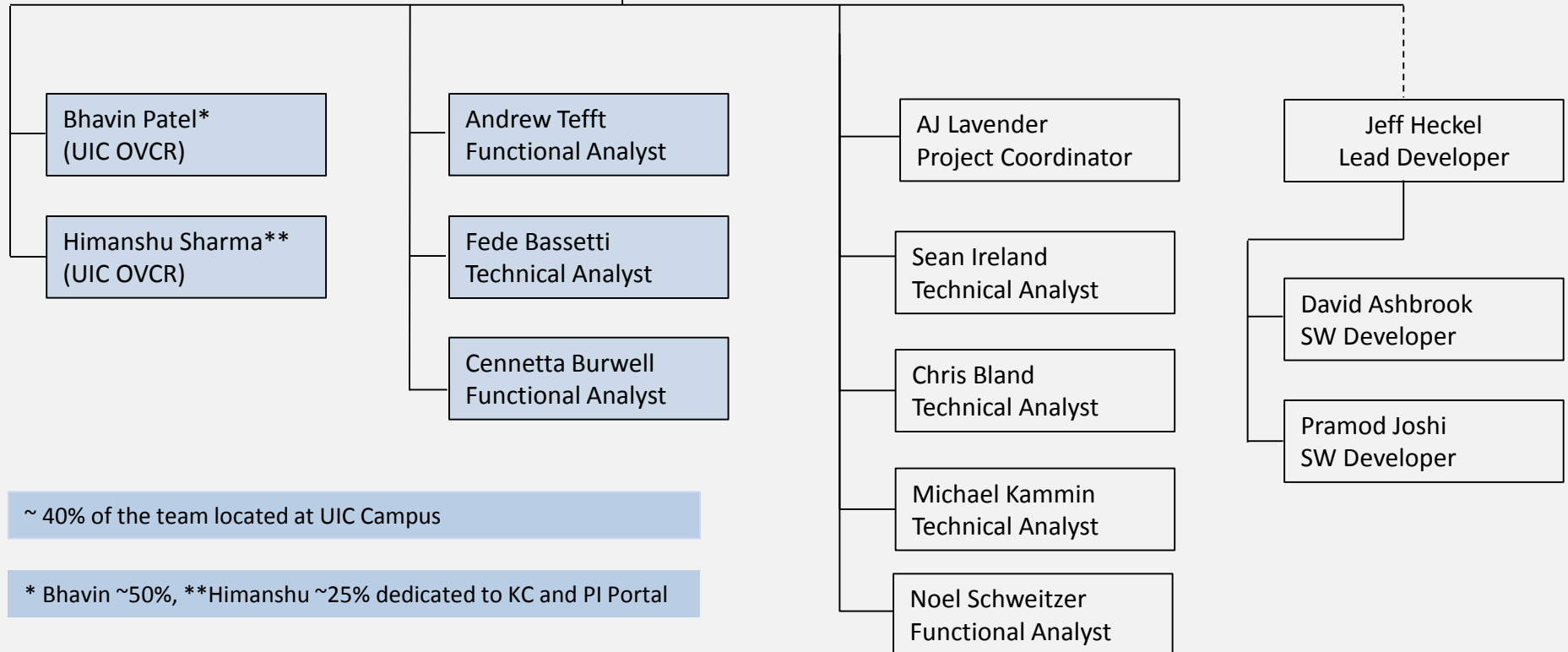
- Meets weekly and manages the functional and technical teams.

PI Portal Pilot Release April 2014

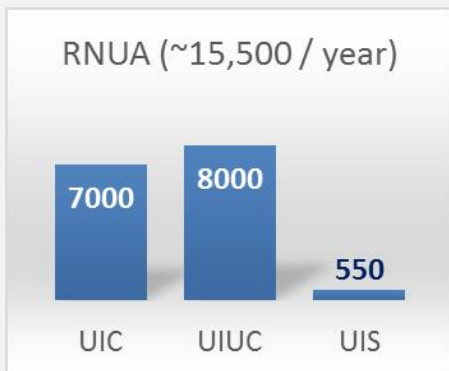
KC is in the process of changing their user interface starting with Pre-Award in 2014.

# KC COI Status

- Target RNUA support for SEP 2014
- Completed 3 weeks of Kualu Coeus (KC) and RICE training using rSmart - A commercial affiliate of Kualu Foundation - (Jan~ Feb)
- Started 2-week Sprint cycles for RNUA COI analysis, configuration, and development
- Pursuing Partner Level Kualu Coeus Membership at the cost of \$90K / year
- UI enhancement mock up and review in progress
  - Continue to explore UI customization capabilities of KC COI module.
  - For future releases (starting late 2015), leverage KC UXI (new User Interface) and KRAD (app development).

# KC COI Benefits

University manually processed ~15,500 RNUA and 3764 PHS disclosures last year



## KC COI Benefits:

- Automatic electronic routing for approvals.
- Paperless system that provides a single source to view, manage and track COI disclosures.
- Data, all disclosure and conflict information, available for reporting.
- Access to prior disclosures & financial entities.
- Common business processes across all three campuses.
- Integration with other KC modules (Proposal, Award, IRB, IACUC, etc.)

# myResearch (PI Portal) Status

- Phase 1 / Pilot Release in April 2014
- Key features:
  - Enable PI to view all Pending Proposals, Pending Negotiations, Active Awards, Non-funded Proposals, Closed Awards.
  - Summary Financial data using standard grants format for Active Awards. Cross walked ~1900 Banner accounts code to 26 categories.
  - Current & Pending award listing.
  - Allow Business Managers to see all grants associated with Principal Investigators in their department.

## PI Benefits:

- All your grant information will be in one place.
- Will integration administrative, financial, and compliance information and provide a yearly record of grant activity.
- PI Portal is being rolled out over the course of several years, and you have a voice in this project.



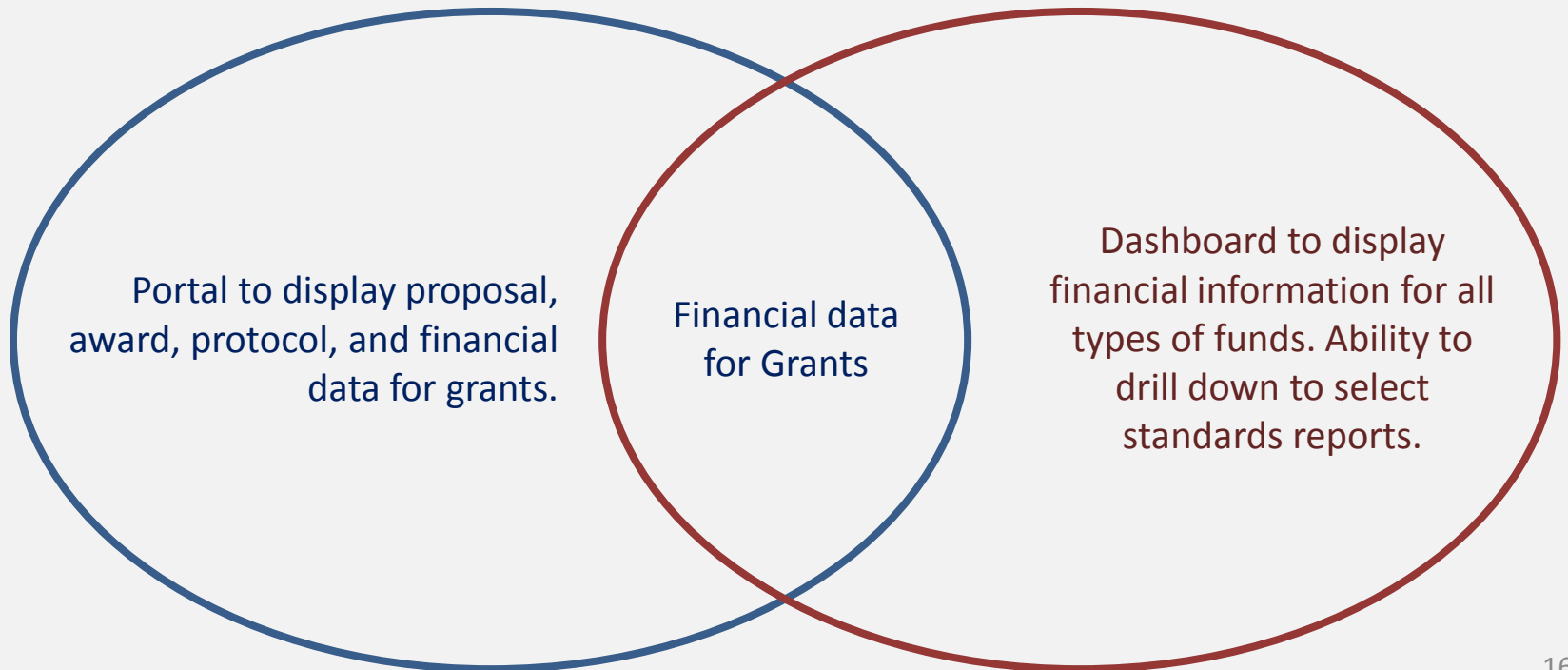
# myResearch & UI Reports Distribution
